Discounts

Multi-Session Discount: Save money by signing up for more than one session! Take \$50 off each session registered for after the first.

Sibling Discount: One-time \$50 discount for every sibling added after the first registered camper.

Military Discount: 25% off summer camp session fees for campers whose parent or legal guardian is classified as active military status serving in the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, National Guard or Reserves. In order to receive this offer, you will need to provide a letter from the Commanding Officer supporting "active duty status" or show your Military ID in person (photo copies are not accepted).

10% off summer camp session fees for campers whose parent or legal guardian is honorably discharged from the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard, National Guard or Reserves. In order to receive this offer, you will need to provide a copy of Form DD214.
