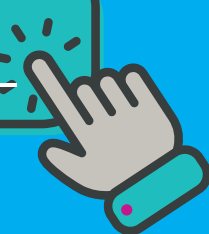

VILLAGE OF THE WEEK

In addition to our weekly themes, villages are also competing to be the Village of the Week winner! Village of the Week is a week-long competition that aims to find the group that displayed group cohesion, camp spirit, and core values. When a village exhibits any of the criteria, they are awarded a Village of the Week coin.

How campers can earn coins:

- displaying support to each other at an activity period; showing sportsmanship
- cleaning activity area at the end of the activity; being responsible by taking all items and leaving nothing behind
- follow all rules in the waterfront areas
- participating in the theme of the week, including dress-up days

We also have random coin earnings that range from the village that bought the most ice cream to the village that had the least amount of absences.
